

## RULES

1. Three people per team, (youth anglers must be 17 yrs. old or younger), (Tournament rules allow for one adult and one youth angler if a second youth angler can not be found for that team.) Proof of age may be required.
2. All Federal, State, Local Sport Fishing and U. S. Coast Guard Regulations apply. Anyone caught breaking these regulations may be disqualified.
3. Registration and rules review will take place at 7:30AM at the Gogebic Lodge.
4. Fishing hours will be from 8:30AM – 3:30PM starting by a trickle start. Any team arriving late is subject to penalty or disqualification. (0-15 minutes late will lose ½ weight . Over 15 minutes will lose total weight.)
5. Your tether kill switch strap must be worn at all times of travel above idle speed.
6. Live well and kill switch operation inspection will take place from 7:45AM – 8:15AM at the main dock and every team's boat must be operational.
7. A maximum of 5 fish, (all walleye) will be allowed to be weighed in. No more than 6 fish in your live well at any time. (The championship in Koneka, Ontario, Canada will be an all walleye tournament.)
8. Stressed fish will be penalized by ½ lb. Dead fish will be disqualified.
9. Prizes will be awarded in order of the teams heaviest weight overall. In the case of a tie, the teams heaviest fish will determine the winner.
10. Everyone must wear their lifejacket at all times.
11. Every team must be present for a group photo at the end of the championship.
12. In order to be eligible for prizes each team must return and report to the main dock by no later than 3:30 PM.
13. Following the BBQ at approximately 4:30PM, the prizes will be awarded.
14. The judges decision will be final.
15. All entries not necessarily accepted and a 20% overbook may be accepted.

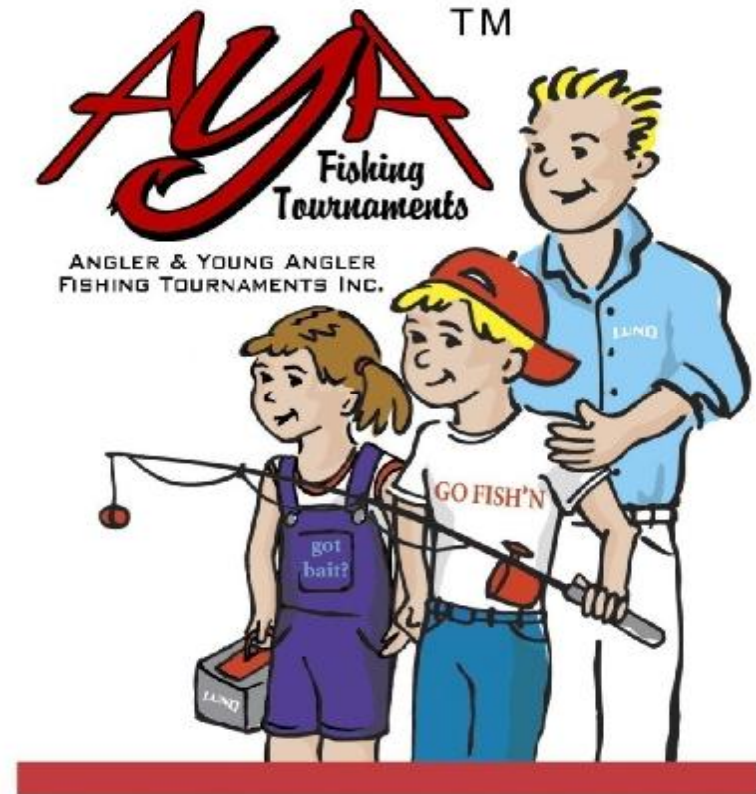
