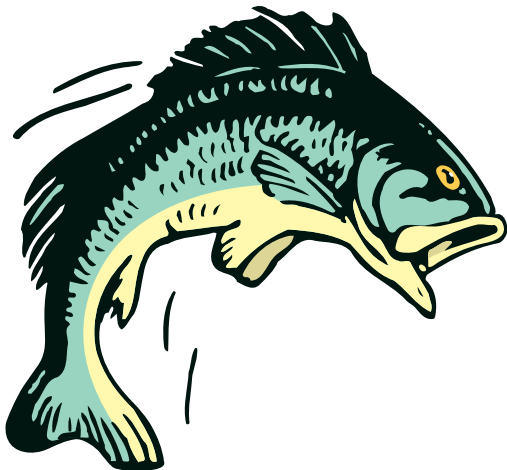
OFFICIAL RULES

1. All fish must be alive.
2. Scale samples may be taken.
3. All contending fish may be opened at weigh-in.
4. All contestants must leave from designated check-in stations.
All boats will be checked (live boxes, voids, etc.) prior to start of day.
5. Each angler must wear current year's tournament hat.
6. All passengers in boats must be registered and registrations must be on their person.
7. There will be no fishing from docks, off shore or in rivers. (Maps will be included with registrations.)
8. No boat may touch or come in contact with any other boat.
9. In the case of ties, entry money from the places that the participant would have won will be divided equally between the participants. Participants limited to one major prize only.
Major prizes are considered over \$100.
10. Any person disobeying rules will be disqualified immediately.
11. The Fishing Committee reserves the right to investigate or contest any fish turned in for contention.
12. Entry fee is \$50 - regardless of day of entry. Registrations must be signed each day at check point.
13. Hats will be given out at check-in.
14. You must have a registration button to be eligible for tagged fish.
15. To aid our patrols, please report any suspected violations to any check-in point.
16. State of Michigan fishing rules will apply.
17. No unmarked fish, which holds a place of contention, can be taken back out in the entrant's boat during tournament hours. The fish can be reclaimed at the end of that day's tournament hours at the location where it was weighed-in.
