

ANNUAL TAGGED and MONTHLY FISHING CONTEST

May 15th through September 9th

- •Annual Tagged Fish Contest requires prior purchase of the current year's button. This contest pertains to all tagged fish caught in Lake Gogebic. Current years fish tag and your registration button will be the same color. Different colored tags represent the different years of the contest.
- Monthly Fishing Contest requires prior purchase of the current year's button. A \$30.00 Gift Certificate will be awarded monthly to the largest fish in each of the following categories: Walleye, Perch, Smallmouth Bass and Northern Pike. Winners will be determined by length. Gift certificate amounts may increase based on the number of entries. Gift certificates may be redeemed at any Lake Gogebic Chamber of Commerce Business.

Monthly periods: May 15th / June 14th - June 15th / July 14th - July 15th / August 14th - August 15th / September 9th.

Buttons may be purchased at many of the local businesses for \$10.00 each. Your support and participation will enable our Chamber to continue to contribute towards lake projects that will enhance the fishery on Lake Gogebic.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. You must have a valid Michigan fishing license. Not required for anyone for Michigan's "Free Fishing Weekends."
- 2. You must have a registration button for each contest. You must purchase the button PRIOR to catching the fish.
- 3. Fish must be legally caught by hook and line during the open season for that species on Lake Gogebic.
- 4. All fish must be brought in fresh with tags intact.
- 5. Anyone catching a fish with a tag from the PREVIOUS YEAR ONLY, during the open season will receive \$25.
- 6. The Fishing Committee reserves the right to investigate or contest any fish turned in for contention.
- 7. STATE OF MICHIGAN LAWS AND FISHING REGULATIONS WILL APPLY.
- 8. OUT OF BOUNDS AREA: Beyond Slate and Merriweather bridges and the Bergland Bay outlet.
